NYU WAGNER SCHOLARSHIPS

We offer a number of competitive scholarships to help you finance your degree. Over 60% of enrolled students from 35+ countries receive institutional aid or scholarships. Scholarship funding is available to full-time, part-time, domestic, and international students.

To Apply:

Submit your online application for admission to NYU Wagner. Recipients are chosen based upon fit for the scholarship program and the strength of application submitted.

FEATURED SCHOLARSHIPS

AmeriCorps Scholarship

Half-tuition scholarship awarded to up to two AmeriCorps alumni pursuing full-time or part-time study.

Dean's Scholarship

Full-tuition scholarship awarded to applicants based on merit and strength of application, regardless of degree program or area of interest.

International Public Service Scholarship

Partial-tuition scholarships awarded to applicants to all degree programs based on merit and strength of application.

Mayor's Graduate Scholarship Program

Scholarship for part-time NYC government employees to pursue part-time graduate study.

NYU Peace Corps Coverdell Fellowship

Half-tuition scholarships offered to a select group of Returned Peace Corps Volunteers, who participate in the NYU Peace Corps Coverdell leadership development program.

Public Service Scholarship

Partial-tuition scholarships awarded to applicants to all degree programs based on merit and strength of application.

Recipients are offered a full-tuition scholarship and a summer internship stipend. Fellowships are open to MPA/MUP full-time applicants who submit their application by the Early Action Deadline.

Georgina and Charlotte Bloomberg Public Service Fellowship

- Supports future public service leaders dedicated to strengthening government, local communities, and civic organizations in the U.S.

David Bohnett Public Service Fellowship

- For students committed to careers in U.S. municipal government and tackling the country's most critical social issues.

Lisa Ellen Goldberg Fellowship

- For students demonstrating exceptional leadership and making an impact in multi-faith communities, philanthropy, the arts, and storytelling.

Henry Hart Rice Urban Studies Fellowship

Federal Financial Aid

U.S. citizens and eligible residents can apply for federal financial aid by completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Available aid may include Unsubsidized Loans and/or Federal Work-Study.
